

NOTICE OF RACE
INLAND NORTH POINTS 3 SAISA REGATTA
November 4th, 2006

HOST: Atlanta Area High School Sailing & LLSC Jr. Program
SITE: Lake Lanier Sailing Club; Flowery Branch, GA.

1. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the current ISSA Procedural Rules, SAISA Supplemental Rules, *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. SCHEDULE OF RACES

Saturday November 4

08:30 Arrival and check-in, boat rigging

09:00 Competitors' Meeting

10:00 Start of first race of day

3. FORMAT

This will be a two-division regatta; teams will rotate through the boats per a rotation posted on the day of the event. Competitors should expect numerous short races with boat rotations as set forth at the skipper's meeting. It will be the goal of the race committee to complete as many rotations as possible, up to one full round robin rotation of boats. Three races in each division must be completed to constitute a regatta. All coaching, including instruction, assistance, equipment or sustenance shall be on shore.

4. SCORING

Scoring will be by the low point system for individual races as modified by ISSA Rule 9. Ties will be resolved per procedural rule 11(c). Note that when the school "team" is composed of 2 or more sailors from different schools the composite team sailor's schools will be indicated on the results. Race highlights with results will be forwarded within 3 days to SAISA for processing & points will be awarded to qualify for participation in SAISA North's Gold or Silver Regattas; the top six gold teams will gain berths in the District Championship & qualifier for the ISSA Mallory Trophy regatta.

5. AWARDS & TROPHIES

Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible after the last race to be sailed in the event.

6. FEES

The entry fee shall be \$35.00 per school team, paid in advance by using the Regatta [Registration](#) and [Waiver](#) forms available on the South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association website (www.saisa.org) under "General Forms - [Samples](#)". Checks, registration form, waivers, and the number of lunches needed should be mailed to: Bob Martin, 1777 Womack Road, Dunwoody, GA 30338. Make checks payable to Bob Martin.

7. ELIGIBILITY

All 2006-07 member schools in good standing of the South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association (SAISA) are eligible. This regatta is a North Points Inland Area regatta. Registration will be accepted first from North Points Inland area teams whose registration is received by **Saturday, October 21st, 2006**; availability will be considered in the order that registrations are received. All other registrations will be considered in the order they are received. All registration must be received by **Saturday, October 28th, 2006**. Once 12 schools have registered, each additional school seeking registration will be notified that their entry will be contingent upon their ability to bring their own 420 sailboat in good racing condition to add to the rotation.

Competitors must attend the school they represent full time and must be in the 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade, as of the date of the Regatta. If your school does not have sufficient sailors to form the necessary teams, we will attempt to "mix and match" sailors from different member schools. An adult team representative is required to accompany each team and be responsible for their conduct on and off the water. The team representative, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent, is expected to have full authority to obtain medical treatment for his/her team members.

Eligible SAISA schools may enter both varsity and JV teams, however only the varsity team score will be used to determine Championship Points. A JV team from eligible schools may also be entered only when pre-approved by SAISA.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available upon check-in at Lake Lanier Sailing Club clubhouse (LLSC).

9. BOATS

Club 420s will be used, and Lake Lanier Sailing Club Juniors and Georgia Tech Sailing will provide 12 boats. Personal safety equipment including US Guard Type III PFDs must be worn by the competitors. It is requested that all teams bring bailers.

10. RACING AREA

The racing will be on Lake Lanier out of the Lake Lanier Sailing Club.

11. DAMAGE

Damage that requires more than normal maintenance is considered a serious incident. If the Protest Committee determines that reasonable care was not used and resulted in damage one or both boats may be disqualified regardless of any alternative penalties already taken. In extreme cases, either or both boats may be excluded from the rest of the regatta and held financially responsible for the damages.

12. FOOD

Lunches will be available Saturday for \$5.00. Reservations for lunches must be made with registration to guarantee availability. Water & Lemonade will be provided.
