

NOTICE OF RACE
SAISA INLAND NORTH POINTS REGATTA V
Dec 9, 2006

HOSTS: LAKE NORMAN, NORTH IREDELL, NORTH MECKLENBURG High Schools
SITE: LAKE NORMAN YACHT CLUB, Mooresville, NC

1. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the current ISSA Procedural Rules and SAISA Supplemental Rules, The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race. Sailors should wear wetsuits or other non-cotton clothing appropriate for water temperatures in the upper 50s.

2. SCHEDULE OF RACES

Saturday Dec 9th

0800 Arrival, check-in and boat rigging

0845 Competitors' meeting

0945 Start of first race of day

3. FORMAT

This will be a two-division regatta; teams will rotate through the boat per a rotation posted on the day of the event. Competitors should expect numerous short races. It shall be the goal of the race committee to complete one full round robin. **Three races in each division must be completed to constitute a regatta.** All coaching, including instruction, assistance, equipment or sustenance shall be on shore.

4. SCORING

Low point system for individual races as modified by ISSA Rule 9. Ties will be resolved per procedural rule 11(c). Points will be awarded to Inland Area teams to qualify for participation in the North Points Gold and the North Points Silver regattas. The Gold regatta will qualify teams for the SAISA District Championship, & the District Championship for the ISSA Mallory Trophy regatta.

5. AWARDS & TROPHIES

Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible after the last race sailed in the event.

6. FEES

The entry fee shall be \$50.00 per school team, paid in advance by using the [registration](#) and [waiver](#) forms available on the SAISA website (www.saisa.org) under "[General Forms – Samples](#)".

7. ELIGIBILITY

All 2006-07 member schools of the South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association (SAISA) are eligible. The regatta is a North Points Inland Area Regatta. All schools must be members in good standing with SAISA. A school may pay SAISA dues at check-in.

All registrations should be received by Mark Aspland no later than Monday, Dec 4, 2006.

Once 12 schools have registered, each school will be notified that their entry shall be contingent upon their ability to bring their own 420 sailboat in **good racing condition** to add to the rotation.

Competitors must attend the school they represent full time and must be in the 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade (8th graders-crew only), as of the date of the Regatta. If your school does not have enough sailors to form the necessary team, we will attempt to "mix and match" sailors from different member schools. An adult school representative/advisor is required to accompany each team and be responsible for their conduct on and off the water. The team representative, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent, is expected to have full authority to obtain medical treatment for his team members.

A JV team from an eligible school may be entered only when pre-approved by SAISA. For JV team approval, contact Tom Monkus at (727) 821-9080. Each JV team may be responsible for providing their own 420, as preference will be given to schools with only one team.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting at Lake Norman Yacht Club.

9. BOATS

Club 420's will be used, and 12 will be provided by Lake Norman Yacht Club.

10. RACING AREA

Racing will be on Lake Norman near Lake Norman Yacht Club, www.lakenormanyachtclub.com

11. DAMAGE

Damage that requires more than normal maintenance is considered a serious incident. If the Protest Committee determines that reasonable care was not used and resulted in damage, one or both boats may be disqualified, regardless of any alternative penalties already taken. In extreme cases, either or both boats may be excluded from the rest of the regatta and held financially responsible for the damages.

12. LUNCHESES

8 Lunches (Sat only) are included in regatta fee; additional lunches will be \$5 each. Reservations for additional lunches MUST BE MADE with registration to guarantee availability. Water will be provided.

13. DIRECTIONS

Lake Norman Yacht Club is located north of Charlotte, NC; follow Interstate 77 to Exit 33. Turn west onto Williamson Road. Go approximately 2 miles to first traffic light and turn left onto Brawley School Road. Go 5.0 miles to traffic circle (you will pass though 1 traffic light along your way). Exit traffic circle on OPPOSITE side as you entered (pretend it was never there). Go 0.9 miles and turn LEFT on Yacht Road. Go 0.8 miles and turn LEFT into LNYC. After entering gate turn left and follow to pavilion.

14. CAMPING / HOTELS

LNYC has great camping and bathing facilities. No hookups are available. No pets. No camping in club buildings. No open fires.

There are also several hotels close by in Mooresville near I-77 Exit 36 and N.C. Highway 150.
