



7.2 All schools must be members in good standing with SAISA. If a school wishes to participate, and has not yet paid the ISSA/SAISA dues, they will be provided the opportunity to pay dues at check-in.

7.3 Registration is on a first paid/first allowed basis. Once 8 schools have registered, each school will be notified that their entry shall be contingent upon their ability to bring a FJ sailboat to add to the rotation.

7.4 Competitors must attend the school they represent full time and must be in the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade, as of the date of the Regatta. **Due to limitations only full A/B division teams should register, with no JV teams and no 8<sup>th</sup> grade students entered for this regatta.**

7.5 An adult school representative/advisor is required to accompany each team and be responsible for their conduct on and off the water. The team representative, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent, is expected to have full authority to obtain medical treatment for his team members.

## **8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions will be available upon check-in.

## **9. BOATS**

Collegiate FJs will be used, and 8 will be provided by the venue. Personal safety equipment including US Coast Guard Type III PFDs must be furnished by the competitors.

## **10. RACING AREA**

Racing will be on Lake Virginia, Winter Park, FL 32789. Rollins College Alford Boat Host will be the site for the regatta. Teams bringing their own boats, please contact H. Smith, Rollins College 407-646-2396.

## **11. LUNCHES**

Plan to bring your own lunch and water.

## **12. DAMAGE**

Damage that requires more than normal maintenance is considered a serious incident. If the Regatta Chairman determines that reasonable care was not used and resulted in damage one or both boats may be disqualified regardless of any alternative penalties already taken. In extreme cases, either or both boats may be excluded from the rest of the regatta and held financially responsible for the damages.

## **13. DIRECTIONS**

13.1 From I-95: take I-4 West to exit 87, Fairbanks Avenue (FL426E) and precede East to Park Avenue, turn right onto Rollins College campus, first stop sign turn left on to Holt Avenue, end of the street, turn right, Alford Boat house will be on your left.

13.2 From Florida Turnpike: take I-4 East to exit 87, Fairbanks Avenue (FL426E) and follow above directions.
